

HAPPENINGS IN OCTOBER

Arrival and Dismissal, Please...

- Bring a thermometer with you and the Brightwheel app open and ready.
- Make sure your approved drop off and pick up people have their codes and know how to work their way through the healthcheck.
- Keep your kids at your side for drop off and pick up. We want to stay on top of our social distancing procedures and keep your kids safe.
- Arrive 9:00 am-9:15 am / Pick-Up 2:15-2:30.
- Drive and park carefully in the parking lot. Please be mindful of any families that may have multiple children in tow.
- Leave the blue dumpster parking spot open so our trash can be picked up at any time.

Preschool Day Reminders

- Please email or Brightwheel message us if your child is absent for the day (including sickness and vacation). We need to have documentation for the MD State Dept. It is important to reference any symptoms or states you visit.
- Keep your child home if there are signs of illness. A doctor's note to return is needed for any sick or telehealth visit. Results and date to return must be noted.
- Check your Brightwheel app for messages and photos.
- Cut up your child's food into bite sized pieces and provide a water bottle.
- Have an extra change of weather appropriate clothing onsite and extra mask for 3s & 4s
- Keep personal toys at home (lovies and binkies are fine)


