Enrollment Opportunities

- Infants/Ones Before Care and After Care until 3:30 pm
- Twos After Care until 3:30 pm on Monday/Wed/Friday
- Twos and Older After Care until 5 pm on Tues Friday



Changing Seasons, Changing Wardrobe

Please help us keep your child comfortable during the colder months.

- Dress your child in layers temps can fluctuate in the classrooms. We try to go outside even on colder days, so we like to be prepared for these weather ranges.
- Please make sure all clothing (especially jackets and sweatshirts) are labeled with your child's name.
- Please remember to replenish and/or switch out extra clothes for the cooler weather. especially for potty training children.

Healthy School, Happy School

- If your child was given any OTC medication in the morning, including throat or cough drops, to treat cold symptoms, please keep them home from school for monitoring.
- A fever is considered 100.4 F and above. Children must remain home until the fever has been gone for 24 hours, without the use of feverreducing medication.
- Nasal discharge should be clear and not thick and colored.
- Necessary allergy meds and antibiotics should be given at home. However, if needed, the preschool can administer medications with approved paperwork signed by the doctor.
